Make sure to take down the name of the person you spoke to and the date. I have a visual disability before I make an appointment I would like to ask the following questions:

- I depend on SCAT for medical transportation and need to schedule a pick up time; do you know how long I will be in the doctor's office?
- Is someone available to help with filling out forms in a confidential manner?
- I will be bringing my service animal.
- Are medical forms and other literature available in large print, or Braille and audiotape?
- Will you provide verbal information and instructions in large print or audiotape?
- Are prescriptions instructions available in large print?
